RULES AND REGULATIONS	

- 1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at The Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
- 2. The Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- 3. Substitution of dogs in the Championship is not permitted.
- 4. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the trial can be made.
- 5. Should circumstances so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to The Kennel Club.
- 6. No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of The Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
- 7. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.
- 8. Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express agreement of the Chief Steward and the Host.
- 9. <u>Welfare of Dogs</u>

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any field trial licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the trial
