Application for a variation of a kennel name





A guide to help you complete an application for a variation of a kennel name

This form should be used by the applicant(s) to vary the ownership of a kennel name. It should be completed and sent to The Kennel Club.

Kennel name

The kennel name word that is to be varied in ownership.

Kennel name holder(s) name & address

The kennel name holder is the person who currently holds an active interest in the kennel name, who wishes to grant a separate interest to the applicant(s). Please complete all contact details here. A kennel name can only be used in the naming of dogs where the ownership of the kennel name and the registered ownership of the dog are identical.

Declaration to be signed by the current kennel name holder(s)

Statement A or B must be signed by the kennel name holder(s) and not by a 3rd party. Failure to do so may result in the granted interest in the kennel name being cancelled.

By signing statement A, you wish to retain your interest in the kennel name and grant a separate interest in the kennel name to the applicant(s). By signing the declaration you acknowledge that you are unable to cancel this interest without the consent of all parties involved and give the same right to the applicant(s) to grant a separate interest to anyone of their choosing. If you are the sole holder of the kennel name, you are also accepting that you will now become a separate interest holder only.

By signing statement B, you are agreeing to relinquish all rights to the kennel name in favour of the applicant(s) and subsequently, your interest in the kennel name will lapse and will no longer be available to youwhen naming puppies.

Name and address of applicant(s)

The applicant is the person in whose name the kennel name is to be registered. Please complete all sections in order for the application form to be accepted. If the ownership of the new interest in the kennel name is to include a member of the existing kennel name ownership, please make sure their name is included in this section.

The declaration must be signed by the applicant(s) in order for the Application to Vary the Ownership of a kennel name to be accepted.

Breed(s)

Please state breed(s) interested in.

The application fee to vary ownership of the kennel name, including the first years maintenance payment is £45.00.

How to pay

- i. An initial fee of £45 is payable to vary the ownership of a kennel name. This includes the registration fee of £25 and the first year's maintenance fee of £20.
- ii. The maintenance of the kennel name will be due for payment annually on the date the new interest in the kennel name was granted. The Kennel Club will notify you four weeks before the annual maintenance payment is due, if paying by credit card or cheque. However, the onus lies with the kennel name holder to ensure payment has been taken.
- iii. If the annual maintenance payment is not made the kennel name interest will lapse and will no longer be available for use in naming puppies in that interest. Important: If you change your name or address, we require notification in writing. Failure to update your details may prevent correspondence relating to kennel name maintenance being delivered, causing the kennel name to become lansed

Direct Debit

We recommend that you complete this section in order to pay for the future annual maintenance payments by Direct Debit. This method will help ensure that your kennel name does not lapse and costs just £18, saving you £2 off the regular annual maintenance fee.

If you prefer, maintenance can be paid by cheque or credit card for an annual fee of £20 online at thekennelclub.org.uk/registration/kennelnames/ or by calling us (see bottom of page).

Returning your application

Once you have completed this form, please send it together with the appropriate fee to the address at the bottom of the page.

- payments are made and as it is spelt, The Kennel Club is under no obligation to disallow minor variations in the naming of puppies. The separate interest in the kennel name will be granted subject to checks, and the certificate will be sent to the applicants. Once granted, details of the vi.
- separate interest in the kennel name will be published in The Kennel Club Journal.
- If as a kennel name holder you wish to gift your holding and ensure that the right to use your kennel name is maintained after your death, then please complete an application to Bequeath the Ownership of a kennel name form, which can be downloaded from our website www.thekennelclub.org.uk/forms vii
- The data and health screening results connected to your dog will be published and used for registration and publication in relevant Kennel Club documentation as well as included in the Health Test Results Finder and Mate Select calculations. To set up a Direct Debit then please go into your account you will need to wait until your first year of renewal before you can set up.

The Kennel Club General code of ethics

All breeders who register their puppies, and new owners who register ownership of their dogs with The Kennel Club, accept the jurisdiction of The Kennel Club and undertake to abide by its general code of ethics.

BREEDERS/OWNERS:

- Will properly house, feed, water and exercise all dogs under their care and arrange for appropriate veterinary attention if and when required.
- will agree without reservation that any veterinary surgeon who performs an operation on any of their dogs which alters the natural conformation of the animal, or who carries out a caesarean section on a bitch, may report such operations to The Kennel Club.
- Will agree that no healthy puppy will be culled. Puppies which may not conform to the breed standard should be placed in suitable homes.
- Will abide by all aspects of the Animal Welfare Act.
- Will not create demand for, nor supply, pupples that have been docked illegally.
- 6. Will agree not to breed from a dog or bitch which could be in any way harmful to the dog or to the breed.
- Will not allow any of their dogs to roam at large or to cause a nuisance to neighbours or those carrying out official duties.
- Will ensure that their dogs wear properly tagged collars and will be kept leashed or under effective control when away from home.

- Will clean up after their dogs in public places or anywhere their dogs are being exhibited.
- will only sell dogs where there is a reasonable expectation of a happy and healthy life and will help with the rehoming of a dog if the initial circumstances change.
- Will supply written details of all dietary requirements and give guidance concerning responsible ownership when placing dogs in a new home.
- 12. Will ensure that all relevant Kennel Club documents are provided to the new owner when selling or transferring a dog, and will agree, in writing, to forward any relevant documents at the earliest opportunity, if not immediately available.
- 13. Will not sell any dog to commercial dog wholesalers, retail pet dealers or directly or indirectly allow dogs to be given as a prize or donation in a competition of any kind. Will not sell by sale or auction Kennel Club registration certificates as stand alone items (not accompanying a dog).
- 14. Will not knowingly misrepresent the characteristics of the breed nor falsely advertise dogs nor mislead any person regarding the health or quality of a dog.

Breach of these provisions may result in expulsion from Club membership and/or disciplinary action by The Kennel Club and/or reporting to the relevant authorities for legal action, as appropriate.
