Chairman, Tony Allcock OBE, opened the AGM by thanking the membership for their presence at what was an important meeting with a significant agenda. Two previous question and answer sessions for the membership had been held to provide an opportunity to answer any questions that members may have had in advance of the AGM.

Tony reflected on some of the achievements of the Club over the past year – which included the great honour of The Kennel Club being granted royal patronage by His Majesty the King, which followed the Club receiving the Royal prefix in its 150th year. At the SGM, which followed the AGM, there was a resounding majority vote by the members for The Kennel Club to change its name with Companies House to The Royal Kennel Club Limited.

Members at the meeting were asked to vote on a number of agenda items, including a rise in registration and membership fees, amendments to the rules governing committees, and a change to the wording of the Club dress code. All of the proposals except the change to the Club dress code were carried.

Mark Beazley, Kennel Club Chief Executive said: “The necessary increases will substantially improve The Kennel Club’s financial resilience and we are grateful to our membership for voting them through today, thus supporting our Club at a challenging and pivotal time, to secure an exciting future.

“As with a lot of organisations at present, we find our Kennel Club within a challenging financial environment. We know that we need to diversify our revenue streams and



work to drive down the levels of subsidisation required across many of our treasured activities. We want to build now on what we have, so that we are best positioned to achieve our purpose. The Board and the Executive team, working hand in hand, will continue to focus on developing ways for The Kennel Club to diversify and strengthen other income streams – an opportunity I am excited and energised by.”

Other matters outlined at the AGM included future opportunities for the Club and the transformation work that has been undertaken so far and will continue in 2024 and beyond.

It was highlighted that a key component will be to improve and re-energise the registrations model to ensure that it has real value and meaning for breeders and puppy buyers and that it prioritises dog health and wellbeing.

Tony Allcock OBE closed the AGM and SGM on a note of thanks to The Kennel Club directors who have tirelessly volunteered their time to the organisation and to the Executive and staff colleagues who have made all the progress possible and demonstrated their dedication and loyalty throughout.

New survey launched to improve understanding of canine spinal problems

The Kennel Club has launched a new online health survey which aims to improve understanding of prevalence and types of spinal (neck, back or tail) problems affecting different pedigree dog breeds.

The survey has been developed to gain insights and identify any breed-specific nuances that may influence the development of spinal problems. The results will inform and direct future research to areas that require further attention.

Open to all dog owners regardless of breed, the survey welcomes participation from current owners and those who have had a dog/s that have sadly passed away.

Charlotte McNamara, Head of Health at The Kennel Club, said: "Spinal problems are sadly becoming increasingly common in some dogs, particularly as they age. They cover a range of abnormalities that affect the neck, back and/or tail. These include, but are not limited to, general pain, degenerative myelopathy (DM), hemivertebrae (HV), intervertebral disc disease (IVDD), and osteoarthritis. Understanding the causes and signs of these conditions is crucial to improving our knowledge and understanding, and

better supporting owners in maintaining their dogs' quality of life.

"We urge owners to kindly spend a few moments to complete the survey for all dogs owned, either now or in the past, even if they have never been affected by spinal problems. By participating, you'll play a crucial role in advancing our understanding and improve our efforts to improve canine spinal health."

The survey will be managed by The Kennel Club and all personal information provided will be kept confidential and presented anonymously. To complete the survey, please visit <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/spinalPR>. The survey should take no more than 10 minutes to complete.

The Kennel Club takes insights from its health data and feeds them into its Breed Health and Conservation plans,

so that it can work with breeders to give information and guidance about how to ensure the future health of pedigree breeds. These plans, which enable The Kennel Club to track progress and make meaningful changes to breed health, have been developed as a result of reviewing more than 4,000 research papers, making the project the most comprehensive review of pedigree health data anywhere in the world.

The Kennel Club also invites all dog enthusiasts to watch its **recent webinar** on IVDD, a common degenerative neurological condition in dogs, which can lead to pain, nerve damage, and even paralysis. During this webinar, Professor Paul Freeman, Principal Clinical Neurologist at the Queen's Veterinary School Hospital, University of Cambridge, talks about what research has told us to date, symptoms, possible treatment options, methods of reducing risk – including details of **The Kennel Club IVDD Scheme for Dachshunds** – and what future research could investigate. The Kennel Club launches new online puppy packs

The Kennel Club has announced the launch of a new online puppy pack for breeders and owners. The pack, which can be accessed by breeders via their Kennel Club online account, is designed to support both breeders and owners in ensuring the best start in life for puppies going to their new home.

The new downloadable packs will offer personalised information about puppies, collated from the breeder's account following details they have added when registering the puppy with The Kennel Club. Information will include the date of birth, description of the dog including colour, markings and any health results for the puppy, as well as for the sire and dam of the puppy registered. Breeders are encouraged to complete all the additional information on the puppy's first six weeks including socialisation, feeding and vaccinations.

Packs will be customised according to breed and will include any specific

health tests the breeder has undertaken for the puppy, inbreeding calculators, as well as breed-specific advice on feeding and grooming, and recommendations to contact breed clubs for specialised information or advice. Health data is vital in The Kennel Club's work to track progress and make meaningful changes to breed health. It's Breed Health and Conservation Plans are bespoke to each breed and provide breeders with guidance about how to ensure the future health of pedigree breeds.

The puppy's microchip number and any activated pet insurance policy number and policy start date will also be

included within the documentation, with an offering of five weeks free insurance with Kennel Club Pet Insurance provided by Agria for breeders to be able to offer their new puppy owner, giving them, and the new owner reassurance in those early days that they are covered instantly.

Helen Fox, The Kennel Club's Chief Commercial Officer, commented: "We have carried out extensive research to find ways for us to help make the puppy buying journey easier.

"Using our findings, we devised an online puppy pack which has been shared with those new to breeding, as well as those who are more established, for input. We are now pleased to launch this new enhanced free of charge feature to Kennel Club litter registration and be able to have a new online facility available to all, which we hope will be of benefit to anyone having a litter of puppies, as well as new owners.

"The new online puppy packs will make the administration process easier for breeders, so they can focus on their puppies, knowing that the new owner will have all the information they need when they leave with their new puppy, helping to give the dog the best start in life."

The Kennel Club welcomes pet abduction bill becoming law

The Kennel Club has welcomed the passing of a new law which will introduce a specific criminal offence for those who steal pets.

Under the Pet Abduction Bill – a Private Member's Bill sponsored by Anna Firth MP – anyone found guilty of stealing a pet will face up to five years in prison, a fine, or both. The Bill passed through its final stage in the House of Lords on 24 May and will become law.

"We're thrilled that this important Bill – which introduces a new and specific offence to tackle pet theft – will become law," comments Dr Ed Hayes, Head of Public Affairs at The Kennel Club. "We applaud the hard and persistent work of every organisation and individual who has been raising awareness of this issue and calling for action for many years."

"Currently, the theft of a pet is treated no more seriously than the theft of a mobile phone, despite the utter heartbreak it causes. This new law is desperately needed to ensure that sentencing provisions reflect a dog's sentience and their role within their family, as well as fully

taking into account the emotional harm inflicted on the victims of this crime."

The Kennel Club has long campaigned on the issue of pet theft, lobbying for sentencing to recognise the emotional value of a dog and for better reporting and recording from officials so that underlying causes of dog theft can be tackled. Its 'Paw and Order' campaign, launched after lockdown to urge action, illustrated the need for reform and spurred thousands of dog lovers across the UK to write to their MP. Statistics gathered as part of the campaign revealed the failure to tackle a crime that is devastating nearly 200 families every month, as just two per cent of dog theft cases in 2020 resulted in a criminal charge.

The Kennel Club launches ‘the dog people’s manifesto’ as dog welfare at ‘crossroads’

Ahead of the General Election, The Kennel Club has launched ‘the dog people’s manifesto’, which calls on the incoming Government to reshape laws surrounding dog welfare, encourage responsible breeding and support owners in best caring for their pet.

The wide-ranging 8-point plan highlights the key issues facing owners and their pets, and details the legislative changes and alternative measures which need to be taken to better dog welfare, advocating education and behaviour change to bring about improvements.

This includes highlighting the delays and then failure of regulations to ban electric shock collars, despite widespread cross-party and public support in the previous Parliament, and urging the incoming Government to ensure this ban comes into a force as a priority, as well as recommending the revision of current legislation around fireworks to reduce unnecessary distress and trauma to pets.

Elsewhere, The Kennel Club – which advocates for those responsible breeders it represents – is calling on an incoming Government to help people who want to breed healthy puppies and find them loving homes with the right families. Currently many low-volume, high-welfare home breeders are being deterred from breeding altogether, leaving a void in the market which is exploited by puppy farmers and rogue sellers who simply breed for profit without any regard for dog health or welfare, or the puppy’s future. The manifesto therefore recommends removing the burdensome ‘business test’ for breeders who breed one or two litters a year, as well as simplifying the steps that breeders of three or four litters need to take in order to get a licence. The Kennel Club

– whilst aware of calls for more stringent regulations – is uniquely placed to make recommendations in this sphere as the only organisation working with breeders, investing in dog health through breeding tools and resources, and ensuring a healthy supply of puppies by developing and offering health testing schemes.

The manifesto also addresses the need for decision-makers to encourage and empower people to exercise their dogs safely and responsibly, as the introduction of Public Spaces Protection Orders (PSPOs) is increasingly leaving dog walkers without accessible or practical spaces to walk their dogs.

Breed specific legislation is another challenge, and The Kennel Club manifesto underlines the need to overhaul the Dangerous Dogs Act, which – with its continued focus on seizing specific breeds or types of dog, rather than ensuring authorities have the power and resource for decisive action at the very early signs of any dog being out of control – has been failing to protect the public since it was introduced more than 30 years ago.

Holly Conway, Head of Public Affairs at The Kennel Club, said: “While animal welfare legislation has made strides forward since 2006, we are now at a crossroads. A lot of legislation concerning dogs – whilst positive and well-intended – is poorly enforced, and as such hasn’t been tested. And with calls for even more regulations rife, we must warn of the potentially many unintended negative consequences which could make it more burdensome



and complicated for law-abiding, dog-loving people to own, breed and care for their pets.

“Instead we urge focus on education and changing behaviours so that those who want to continue to breed, own and care for pet dogs can do so in a sensible, well-informed and responsible way. As an organisation which invests entirely in improving the health and welfare of dogs and working with responsible breeders, we very much look forward to working with an incoming Government to ensure previous obligations, like banning cruel electric shock collars, are prioritised, and that further measures are put in place to protect dog welfare and to help more owners provide the best care for their pets.”

The Kennel Club marks five years of breathing scheme and collaborates with CVS to engage more vets

The Kennel Club is marking five years since the inception of its ground-breaking respiratory assessment, developed to improve and protect the health of Bulldogs, French Bulldogs and Pugs.

The Kennel Club/University of Cambridge Respiratory Function Grading (RFG) scheme was launched in 2019 and is the only practical, evidence-based tool currently available in the UK to collect data on Brachycephalic Obstructive Airway Syndrome (BOAS), help owners to understand their dog's respiratory function, and crucially, help breeders to identify and breed away from this disease. Over 3,500 Bulldogs, French Bulldogs and Pugs have now been assessed in the UK, including almost 300 for free at Crufts as part of a drive to increase uptake and ensure a healthier future for these popular brachycephalic breeds.

More than 50 vets are now approved RFG assessors, ensuring the scheme is accessible to breeders and owners across the UK. The Kennel Club is also pleased to be working in collaboration with one of the UK's largest vet groups, CVS, to encourage and enable more vets to become RFG scheme assessors and build the infrastructure for more wide-scale health testing.

The next training day is scheduled for the 11 October at Granta Veterinary Specialists, Station Road, Linton, CB21 4NW.

The scheme is also now licensed and used in 18 countries worldwide (Australia, Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Iceland, Ireland, Mexico, Netherlands, New Zealand,

North America, Norway, Portugal, Romania, Sweden, Switzerland and Taiwan), enabling wider data collection on BOAS and promoting an international and collaborative approach to improve and protect breed health for current and future generations.

Charlotte McNamara, Head of Health at The Kennel Club, commented: "We would like to thank all those breeders, owners, vets and organisations who have helped to build the foundations of this important scheme.

"We look forward to continuing to work with CVS, vets and other collaborative parties dedicated to improving brachycephalic dog health across the board through promoting

the scheme – increasing its uptake and access – and engaging vets, breeders and puppy-buyers to raise awareness and understanding of BOAS.

"This collaboration is key in improving dog health across the board – by working together we can make a difference for dogs."

In line with the scheme's evolution and data collected from its first five years, the breeding guidelines for dogs assessed as grade 2 are being updated. The grading system currently categorises mating pairs into green (lowest risk), amber (higher risk), and red (not recommended due to high risk) based on the likelihood of producing BOAS-affected puppies. From 1 June 2024, all mating pairings that include a grade 2 dog will be designated as 'amber', not solely on genetic basis, [Continued>>](#)

but with consideration for the welfare of the dogs involved in the mating and whelping processes. The updated guidance can be found at thekennelclub.org.uk/rfgs.

“Health schemes should be reviewed and adapted as we continue to collect more evidence and understand more about often complex conditions and diseases,” added Charlotte. “The RFG scheme breeding guidelines, which are based on best practice as outlined by expert geneticists, are determined by data and will change in line with the breed populations – underlining the importance of continuing big data collection.

“Whilst the scheme has been in its infancy, we have worked hard alongside vets and committed breeders to make it more accessible and collect data to inform protocols and breeding guidelines. Our health schemes are continually reviewed as they evolve to ensure they are effective in reducing disease

and improving dog health, but are also pragmatic and practical.”

The Kennel Club takes insights from research and feeds them into its Breed Health and Conservation plans, so that it can work with breeders to give information and guidance about how to ensure the future health of pedigree breeds. These plans, which enable The Kennel Club to track progress and make meaningful changes to breed health, have been developed as a result of reviewing more than 4,000 research papers, making these plans the most comprehensive review of pedigree health data anywhere in the world.

The organisation continues to urge further collaboration between all stakeholders on the issues facing brachycephalic dogs and last year launched its Play Your Part report, detailing the collaborative measures that need to be taken by the puppy buying public, breeders, vets, government and The Kennel Club to protect and improve the health of current and future generations, including:

- Health screening, including increasing uptake of the University of Cambridge/ Kennel Club Respiratory Function Grading scheme;
 - Education and behaviour change of breeders, puppy buyers and dog owners, and the role of online marketplaces which advertise pets;
 - Introducing mandatory contracts for breeders and overhauls to Codes of Practices on caring for dogs.

Microchipping for cats now compulsory

The Government has announced that microchipping is now a legal requirement for cats in England as of 10 June 2024. The new rules mean that cats must be implanted with a microchip before they reach the age

of 20 weeks and their contact details stored and kept up to date on a pet microchipping database. Owners found not to have microchipped their cat will have 21 days to have one implanted, or may face a fine of up to £500.

The Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra) estimates that as many as 2.8 million cats in the UK are unchipped, meaning that it would be difficult to reunite them with their owner if they get lost or stolen.

Political canine candidate Coco is crowned Senedd Dog of the Year

Coco, a three-year-old Cavalier King Charles Spaniel has been crowned winner of the inaugural Senedd Dog of the Year competition.

Coco, who entered the event with Jack Sargeant, Welsh Labour MS for Alyn and Deeside, impressed the judges with her loveable character as well as their strong bond with Jack Sargeant MS.

The Senedd Dog of the Year competition, organised by The Kennel Club and Dogs Trust, took place for the first time today in Britannia Park, Cardiff. Coco showed dogged determination as she battled it out to defeat other 'paw-litical' opponents to win the coveted title of Senedd Dog of the Year, arguably the most sought-after accolade in Welsh politics.

Winning MS, Jack Sargeant said of their winning moment: "It's absolutely fantastic to be crowned Senedd Dog of the Year with the wonderful Coco. She's a real companion animal to me, I couldn't be more proud of her."

AMENDMENTS TO BREED STANDARD

At its recent meeting the Board approved the following amendments:

NEWFOUNDLAND

GENERAL APPEARANCE Well balanced, compact, impresses with strength, great activity **and effortless power. Large, double coated, deep bodied, muscular and strong with** substantial bone throughout, but not giving heavy inactive appearance. Noble, majestic and powerful.

(Insertion in bold)

CHARACTERISTICS **A multipurpose dog, at home on land and in water, the Newfoundland is capable of draught work and shows natural lifesaving abilities. He has evolved to withstand the rigours of extreme climate and the sea's adversity. Devoted companion.**

(Amendment in bold)

HEAD AND SKULL Head broad and relatively large, **slightly arched crown**, occipital bone well developed. No decided stop. Muzzle **broad throughout its length** and rather square, clean cut, covered with short fine hair. **Depth and length of muzzle approximately equal. Length from tip of nose to the stop slightly less than from stop to occiput. Forehead, muzzle and face free of wrinkle. Nostrils large, open, well-pigmented. Nose: Black in black, and in white and black dogs; brown in brown dogs.**

(Insertions in bold)

EYES Relatively small, **almond shaped**, not showing haw, set rather wide apart. **Eyelids must fit closely**, free from obvious eye problems. **Colour: dark brown in black, or in white and black dogs, lighter shades of brown which complement the coat colour permitted in brown dogs. Any other eye colour is undesirable.**

(Insertions in bold)

EARS **Triangular, relatively small, with rounded tips, covered with short hair. Set level with, or slightly above the brow, lying close to head.**

(Amendment in bold)

MOUTH Soft and well covered by **tight lips. Loose lips and heavy jowls undesirable.** Scissor bite is preferred i.e. upper teeth overlapping lower teeth and set square to the jaws, but pincer bite tolerated.

(Insertions in bold)

NECK Strong, **muscular**, well set on to shoulders, **long enough to permit dignified head carriage. No excessive dewlap.**

(Insertions in bold)

FOREQUARTERS **Shoulders muscular and well laid back. Elbows directly below the highest point of withers, fitting close to sides. Forelegs well muscled, substantially boned, perfectly straight and parallel. Distance from elbow to ground about half height at withers. Pasterns are strong and slightly sloping.**

(Amendment in bold)

BODY **Length of body from point of shoulders to point of buttock is greater than height at withers. Body is compact. Topline level and firm. Back broad, strong and muscular. Loin well muscled. Croup broad and slightly sloping. Chest deep, fairly broad with brisket reaching at least to elbows. Ribs well sprung. Flank deep. Underline almost level and never tucked up. In bitches, body may be slightly longer.**

(Amendment in bold)

HINDQUARTERS **Powerful, muscular, substantially**

boned. Upper thighs wide and muscular. Stifle well bent, but not giving a crouching appearance. Lower thighs strong and fairly long. Hocks well set down and well apart, parallel to each other; they turn neither in nor out. Viewed from rear, legs straight and parallel. Cow hocks highly undesirable.

(Amendment in bold)

FEET **Large, well rounded, tight and cat like. Webbing of toes is present.** Splayed or turned out feet highly undesirable.

(Amendment in bold)

TAIL **Tail set in line of croup. Strong and broad at base, reaching to or slightly below hock. Fair thickness, well covered by hair. When standing the tail hangs downwards with slight curve at end; when moving carried slightly up, and when excited straight out with only a slight curve at end.** Tails with a kink or curled over the back highly undesirable.

(Amendment in bold)

GAIT **Free with characteristic slight roll of skin. Good reach and strong drive, giving impression of effortless power while retaining level top line.** When in motion slight toeing in at front is acceptable.

(Amendment in bold)

COAT Double, flat and dense. **Outer coat of coarse texture and oily nature, water resistant. Slight wave permissible. Undercoat soft and dense. When brushed the wrong way coat falls back into place naturally. Feathering present on all legs.**

(Amendment in bold)

COLOUR Only permitted colours are:

Black: dull jet black may be tinged with bronze. **White markings acceptable on chest, toes and tip of tail.**

Brown: **Chocolate or bronze. White markings acceptable on chest, toes and tip of tail.**

Landseer (white and black): predominantly white with black markings. Head with or without white blaze. Black saddle, black rump extending to tail. Coat white with minimal ticking. Markings should be considered only when judging dogs of otherwise comparable quality and never at expense of type, structure and soundness.

(Amendments in bold)

SIZE Average height at shoulder: dogs 28ins (71cms), bitches 26ins (6 cms).

Average weight: dogs 141-152lbs (64-69kgs), bitches 110-120lbs (50-54.5kgs).

While size and weight are important it is essential that **balance, symmetry, and substance** is maintained.

BOUVIER DES FLANDRES

HEAD AND SKULL In proportion to build and stature general impression is of strength, accentuated by beard and moustache. Head clean cut. Skull well developed, flat, somewhat longer than wide. **Topline of skull and muzzle are parallel.** Proportions of skull to muzzle are 3:2. Stop shallow, but appears deep due to upstanding eyebrows. Muzzle broad, powerful, well boned, straight in upperline, sloping slightly toward nose which should never become pointed. Circumference measured just in front of eyes approximately equal to length of head. Nose should be very well developed, thus extending the foreface in a slightly convex line towards its tip, rounded at edges, always black. Nostrils wide. Cheeks flat and clean.

The items required to complete the Annual Returns are listed in the Kennel Club Year Book, under C Regulations Secretaries of Breed Clubs, Breed Councils, General Canine Societies, Training Clubs and Agricultural/Municipal Societies should note that all items must be forwarded each year, even if there are no changes from the previous year. Any proposed changes to rules must be clearly

indicated. In the case of a Breed Club which uses its Breed Council's judges lists, this fact should be clearly notified in a covering letter.

For Breed Clubs and Councils, criteria for inclusion on judges lists must also be submitted. Any proposed amendments to the criteria must be highlighted and approval sought.

Breed Clubs are also required to submit the Kennel Club Code of Ethics with any additional clauses as part of the Annual Returns.

We would like to remind secretaries that if your club is required to submit the Officers and Committee list, we require the full names, positions, addresses, contact numbers and email addresses (where possible) of all the officers and committee members.

- Balance sheet (signed)
- Rules/Constitution
- Total number of members (for Dog Training clubs only)

Breed Council Annual Returns:

- Rules
- Email/telephone number for the member club's representative
- Officers with contact information (addresses, contact numbers, email addresses where possible)
- Accounts
- List of societies
- Judges list
