


Step by Step: Draw an Airedale Terrier




Starting with the head, draw a small circle with your HB pencil. Keep these marks very gentle and light so they're easier to rub out later on.

From here you can then use straight lines to create a rough shape of the Airedale. Using little circles, you can also mark out the nose and eye.



Now for the fun bit! Time to start bringing the Airedale to life with some shading!

If you have a harder pencil than the HB then use this to create scribbles where the shadows are. If you just have the one pencil, don't worry, just press harder with it.





Using the reference photo and the lines you drew in step 1, you can now start creating the shape of the terrier. Remember they aren't smooth coated so you can create some texture here.

Once you've completed your shape, use the eraser to remove your original lines and circles.



Keep on shading where you see shadows and, pressing even harder, or with an ever darker pencil, you can create markings.

What you'll need:

- HB Pencil if you have different hardness ones (2B, 4B etc) too then great! But don't worry if you don't.
- Eraser
- Paper
