Equipment & Progression Panel Report for January 2024 WTLC meeting

The Equipment & Progression Panel was formed to look into and progress suggestions/feedback from the WT community and relevant matters raised at WTLC meetings.

Over the months, suggestions/feedback have been put forward and it is important that these topics are then placed on the WTLC Agenda to allow discussion and further feedback before being presented to the WTLC for consideration.

A summary of the topics put forward over 2023, and the subsequent conclusions are as follows –

1. Small dogs to be able to progress to TD with their reduced ju	ımps rejected by WTLC
2. Extra commands in CD Stake exercises to allow for progressi through the stakes in those exercises	on agreed by WTLC
3. Jumps to be progressed in size through the stakes, allowing reduced jumps in early stakes	for rejected by WTLC
4. Pre CD Stakes (without agility) to be recognised by the KC ar allow formal qualifications for younger / less experienced do	
5. Progression of down stay format through the early stakes or graded marking system	rejected by WTLC
6. CD Sit stay to be shown as "in sight"	agreed by WTLC
7. Discussion re WT Warrant (as per agility/obedience) –	rejected by WTLC
8. All societies to contribute with ideas for how WT could progress and grow in light of concerns raised over the low trial entries	no response from most Reps
 Improve communication within the WT community over Liaison Council matters via social media, in a similar format to that of Obedience & Agility 	no response from most Reps

This may seem a lot of proposed changes over the year; they have all been with the focus on encouraging new people into the sport, and keeping them there.

They were all put forward by the WT Community who we continue to encourage to give any topic feedback/suggestions to their Society Reps and/or the E&P Panel.
