STANDARD

The training days are for handlers wishing to improve and further their field trial skills under the guidance and tuition of highly experienced gundog trainers.

Training will be undertaken on dummies only, starting pistols or shotgun blanks may be used during the training sessions.

The training is open to Open and Novice dogs, but it is advisable that in order to get the most out of the training experience, a good level of obedience must be in place. All dogs attending must be steady and familiar with gunfire.

The trainers will aim to equip owners with the techniques and skills that will improve their abilities as a handler, help identify and solve any problem areas and improve their partnership with their dogs.

DRAW

A ballot will be held should the training be oversubscribed. The draws will be performed in accordance with The Kennel Club Ltd Rules, Field Trial and Gundog Working Test Regulations (J) - Reg. J6j.

WITHDRAWALS

Withdrawals from the training day will be made in accordance with J6f. After an applicant has been successful in the draw for a place on the training day, or if reserve has accepted an offer of a place, if the place is not taken up, the applicant may become liable for the full entry fee.

KENNEL CLUB MEMBERSHIP

If you are a member of The Kennel Club, your name will be published in The Kennel Club red Year Book for the current season. You will have been approved as a member by The Board and will have a unique membership number. Owning a registered dog does not automatically qualify you as a member of The Kennel Club.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Dogs entered at Gundog Working Tests held under Kennel Club J Regulations must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
- 2. The Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- 3. Substitution of dogs is permitted, subject to the dog being appropriately qualified.
- 4. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the event can be made.
- 5. If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to a place shall be decided by ballot.
- 6. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.
- 7. No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement inappropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
- 8. Judges at a Test are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.
- 9. Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express agreement of the Chief Steward and the Host.

POSTPONEMENT OR CANCELLATION OF EVENTS

We reserve the right to amend and reschedule the date of the Show or cancel where we need to do so in exceptional circumstances which are beyond the control of The Kennel Club. In the event of a postponement of the Show the entry fees will be transferred to the postponed date. The Kennel Club will have no further liability whatsoever, including (but not limited to) any direct or indirect consequential loss or damage, loss of enjoyment or travel or accommodation costs.

WELFARE OF DOGS

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action default, omission or otherwise. Breach of The Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the event.

Bitches in season will not be permitted.
