Spectators are most welcome to come along and watch the Championship. These notes are intended to help you plan your day and contain important safety information.

**The Meet**

The meet will be just through the entrance to Aggregate Industries Heights Quarry - **DL13 1PF**

**4x4 parking** will be in the adjacent field and cars will be able to park just off the A689 on the hard standing.

Kennel Club road signs will be placed on all approach roads. When you arrive, there will be steward to guide you to a parking place, please follow their directions.

**Start and Finish Time**

The Championship will start both days at the meet with announcements being made at **9am**. We will then move off to the trial ground. The trial will continue throughout the day finishing at approximately 3pm. **We will be travelling from the meet in convoy**. There is **limited parking** at both the meet area and running ground and it is advisable that vehicles are not left at the meet area for the duration of the day. Where possible, judges, competitors and spectators are pleased asked to vehicle share when travelling to the meet to reduce the volume of vehicles in attendance.

**Catering & Facilities**

Unfortunately due to the limited time frame there will be no toilet facilities or on site catering at the Championship ground. Spectators are expected to make their own arrangements for lunch, please ensure that you bring something to eat and drink with you.

**Spectators Gallery**

Spectators will follow the trial at a suitable distance behind the 'line' of the competing dog, the guns and judges so that a dog's work is not disturbed. There will be at least one steward holding a red flag and spectators will be required to remain behind the flag and follow the direction of the steward. This is for your safety and that of others.

Note that once on the trial ground, it may not be possible to leave until the end of the trial due to the remoteness of the location. Anyone wishing to leave **MUST** seek the permission of the Chief Steward, but should be prepared to stay the whole day.

### **Non-Competing Dogs**

Dogs that are not competing in the Championship are **not permitted** on trial ground or allowed to walk around with their owner. Therefore, please do not bring your dog with you.

### **On Site First Aid**

An event medic will be on site to respond and manage any emergency incidents that may occur whilst attending the Championship.

**The event medic is unfortunately not able to treat long standing injuries or illnesses.**

Whilst the medic will be available to assist if urgently required, both competitors and spectators must have a reasonable level of fitness to attend the championship. All attendees must be physically able to follow the championship line for the full duration of the day.

Please note that there is no mobile signal on the majority of the Estate.
